#### **Tuition**

\$2100 - \$250 per student discount = US \$1850 (CAD ~ \$2,494.36) plus the cost of books which is approx. US \$120 (CAD ~ \$161.80). There is an additional US \$40 (CAD ~ \$53.93) fee to cover the debit/credit card charges incurred by the school. The \$40 charge can be avoided by using EFT (see invoice for details). Registration deadline is August 15th. A deposit of US \$440 (~ CAD \$593.25) to secure your place in the cohort is due by September 15th. The remaining tuition can be paid out monthly. You will be invoiced directly from Sustainable Faith.
