




WHY WE FAST AN INVITATION TO FASTING & FEASTING

WHAT DOES SCRIPTURE SAY ABOUT FASTING? "Jesus replied, "Do wedding guests mourn while celebrating with the groom? Of course not. But someday the groom will be taken away from them, and then they will fast."

HOW SHOULD WE APPROACH FASTING?

WHAT HAPPENS WHEN WE FAST?
